Founded in 1973, the National Gay and Lesbian Task Force Foundation (The Task Force) was the first national lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) civil rights and advocacy organization and remains the movement's leading voice for freedom, justice, and equality. We work to build the grassroots political strength of our community by training state and local activists and leaders, working to strengthen the infrastructure of state and local allies, and organizing broad-based campaigns to build public support for complete equality for LGBT people. Our Policy Institute, the community's premiere think tank, provides research and policy analysis to support the struggle for complete equality. As part of a broader social justice movement, we work to create a world that respects and makes visible the diversity of human expression and identity where all people may fully participate in society. Headquartered in Washington, DC, we also have offices in New York City, Los Angeles, and Cambridge. The Task Force is a 501(c)(3) corporation incorporated in Washington, DC. Contributions to The Task Force are tax-deductible to the full extent allowed by law.

The National Gay and Lesbian Task Force, Inc. ("NGLTF, Inc."), founded in 1974, works to build the grassroots political power of the LGBT community to win complete equality. We do this through direct and grassroots lobbying to defeat anti-LGBT ballot initiatives and legislation and pass pro-LGBT legislation and other measures. We also analyze and report on the positions of candidates for public office on issues of importance to the LGBT community. NGLTF, Inc. is a 501(c)(4) non-profit corporation incorporated in New York. Contributions to NGLTF, Inc. are not tax-deductible.

South Beach AIDS Project

As we enter the 25th year of the AIDS pandemic, we're proud that the South Beach AIDS Project is here, making sure that we have the information and resources we need to keep ourselves safe and take care of ourselves if we're infected. With a deep belief in community involvement and empowerment, SoBAP offers services ranging from anonymous and confidential HIV testing to support groups for long-term AIDS survivors and the newly diagnosed to online listings of HIV/AIDS service providers. A past recipient of grants from Winter Party, SoBAP is an important member of the South Florida community.

SoBAP will be at the Beach Party and all Winter Party Festival dance events handing out condoms and safer sex kits. Be smart, be safe, take good care of yourself.

None of this would be possible without the help of hundreds of volunteers, dozens of community groups and local businesses, and the support of the City of Miami Beach, the Miami-Dade County Tourist Development Council and the Greater Miami Convention & Visitors Bureau. I want to extend special recognition to this year's Event Chair, Joe Guerrero, and the members of the Winter Party Festival Executive Committee and Cultural Committee for the countless hours they have donated to make the festival enjoyable for thousands of people.

Welcome to sunny, warm Miami and Winter Party.



Winter Party History

Winter Party, begun in February of 1994, was originally conceived as a one-time event for the specific purpose of raising money to defeat an anti-gay amendment to the Florida Constitution. 1,000 guests attended the first Winter Party. Because of its success, the Dade Human Rights Foundation (DHRF) was formed in 1995 to not only continue Winter Party but to create other ways to raise money and fund projects important to the local LGBT community.

In the course of its existence, DHRF (renamed the Gay & Lesbian Foundation of South Florida in 2002) raised over \$1.2 million for South Florida LGBT organizations, primarily through Winter Party and the annual Recognition Evening. The Foundation was able to award grants ranging from over \$100,000 to SAVE Dade for that organization's successful campaign to preserve Miami-Dade's non-discrimination law, to dozens of smaller grants to local educational, arts and social service organizations.

Last year the Foundation closed its doors and transferred the rights to produce Winter Party and the Recognition Evening to the National Gay and Lesbian Task Force. Founded in 1973, The Task Force was the first national LGBT civil rights and advocacy organization and remains our movement's leading voice for freedom, justice and equality.

In 2005, Winter Party becomes a true festival, offering not just outstanding dance parties – including the world's most fabulous Beach Party – but also a slate of cultural events including art, food, fashion, film and more. Most importantly, the tradition of raising money for the South Florida LGBT community continues.

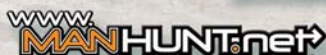

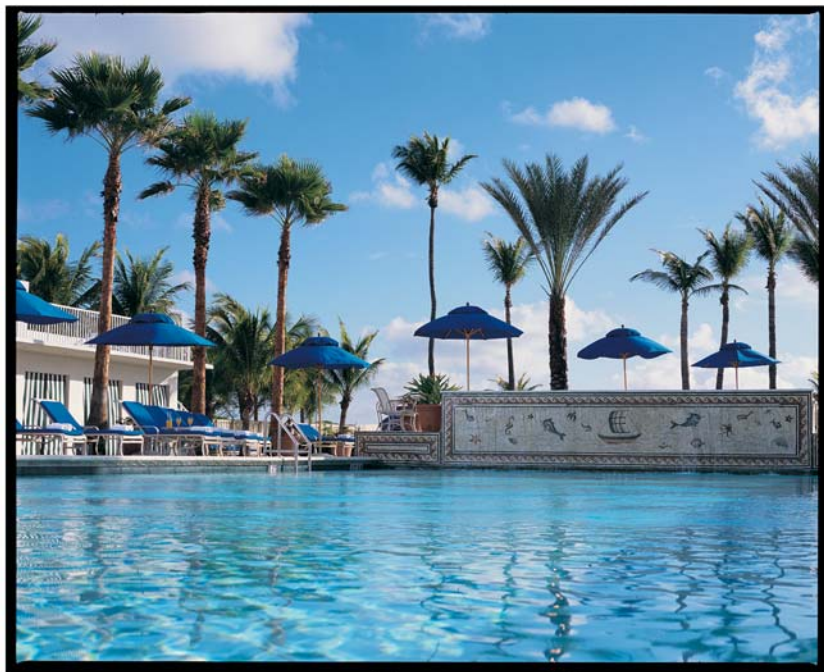
